The servicing of your automobile installment purchase contract has been transferred from ACC Consumer Finance to Consumer Portfolio Services, Inc. ("CPS"). The creditor on whose behalf we are collecting this debt is ACC Master Holding LLC. This transfer of servicing will have no effect on the terms or conditions of your automobile contract. CPS has assigned to you a new account number that is shown on a letter we mailed to you on November 7, 2009.

If your payment schedule has been affected by a concluded or pending bankruptcy proceeding, please forward a copy of this letter to your counsel and/or the trustee, as appropriate, and ask them to call the CPS Bankruptcy Department at 800-342-9248.

Otherwise (absent bankruptcy), please continue to make your monthly payments according to your current payment schedule. The address for all future payments is:

If you choose to pay by **Western Union Quick Collect**, please use your new CPS account number and make the payment to City Code "CPS" and State Code "CA." If you have a monthly scheduled recurring payment through Western Union (*not* Quick Collect), your payment will automatically be redirected to CPS.

If you choose to pay by **Money Gram** please use your new CPS account number and use the Receive Code "3155."

If you have recently sent a payment to ACC, it will be forwarded to us for processing.

IF YOU ARE IN BANKRUPTCY, OR THE DEBT HAS BEEN DISCHARGED IN BANKRUPTCY, THE AUTOMATIC STAY OR THE DISCHARGE INJUNCTION PREVENTS ANY ATTEMPT TO COLLECT THE DEBT. IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED A DISCHARGE IN BANKRUPTCY, YOU NO LONGER HAVE ANY PERSONAL LIABILITY ON THE DEBT BUT YOUR CURRENT CREDITOR, ACC Master Holding, LLC, RETAINS A LIEN ON YOUR VEHICLE. THIS IS NOT AN ATTEMPT TO COLLECT THE DEBT OR TO EXERCISE CONTROL OVER YOUR PROPERTY OR PROPERTY OF THE ESTATE.
